I am directed to refer to your letter dated 13.06.2017 on the subject mentioned above received in the Ministry through Prime Minister Office and to say that it has come to the notice of this Ministry that vide amendment notification dated 05.06.2017 in the TEQ Regulations the condition of 3 year experience as Junior Resident in a recognized Medical College in the concerned subject as a prior requirement for the post of Assistant Professor has been included.

2. A D.O. dated 27.07.2017 from Joint Secretary has been issued requesting MCI to provide this Ministry an amendment proposal in TEQ Regulations deleting 3 years junior residency and to specifically mention DNB along with MD/MS in the academic qualification for various faculty posts. The matter is being pursued with MCI and a decision will be taken on receipt of their recommendations.
